THE ST MARTIN'S with ST PETER'S CHURCH ELECTORAL ROLL

In 2019 our Church Electoral Roll has to be completely re-written. **Everyone who wants to be on the roll has to re-apply. If you do not, then your name will be removed from the roll.** Once the new roll is published and confirmed you will not be able to re-apply until after the APCM (Annual Parochial Church Meeting) on Sunday April 14th.

The Electoral Roll application forms will be available in early February and our new roll must be completed no later than March 17th. Remember that this is your chance to be involved in the decision-making of the parish so it is an important opportunity.
