THE ST MARTIN'S with ST PETER'S CHURCH ELECTORAL ROLL

If you do not, then your name will be removed from the roll.** Once the new roll is published and confirmed you will not be able to re-apply until after the APCM (Annual Parochial Church Meeting) on Sunday April 14th.

The Electoral Roll application forms are now available and our new roll must be completed no later than March 17th. Remember that this is your chance to be involved in the decision-making of the parish so it is an important opportunity.
