## **THE ST MARTIN'S with ST PETER'S CHURCH ELECTORAL ROLL**

If you do not, then your name will be removed from the roll.** Once the new roll is published and confirmed you will not be able to re-apply until after the APCM (Annual Parochial Church Meeting) on Sunday April 14<sup>th</sup>.

The Electoral Roll application forms are now available and our new roll must be completed no later than March 17<sup>th</sup>. Remember that this is your chance to be involved in the decision-making of the parish so it is an important opportunity.
