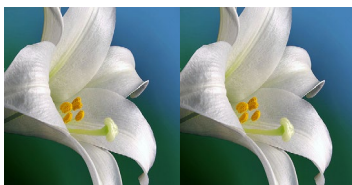
OPPORTUNITIES to serve

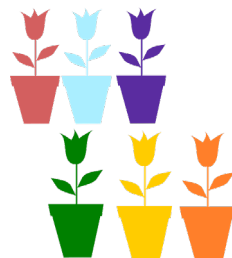
